



Technical Tip 09 - Running BXBwebsuite from another application

If another application needs to call BXBwebsuite by passing parameters, these must be passed via POST method. Accepted parameters:

User (mandatory) - must be passed along with *Password* and *Company* to login automatically
Password (mandatory) - encrypted with the MD5 hash algorithm
Company - if not pass this parameter, or pass empty, considers the main company
Module - module to open (BXBanalytics, BXBdashboard, BXBmonitor or BXBreports); if not pass this parameter, opens the user's default module
HideHeader
HideFooter
HideHeaderAndFooter
HideUserSettings – hide user settings button
HideLogout – hide logout button
